Subject: Abeyance order of M/s Vishwakarma Steel Industry, Ganga Nagar, Bantalab, Jammu.

ORDER No.: 140 -JKPCC of 2024
DATED 02 -08-2024

Whereas, closure of **M/s Vishwakarma Steel Industry, Ganga Nagar, Bantalab, Jammu** was ordered by the JKPCC vide order No. **327 JKPCC of 2024** dated **22-02-2024** for the failure of the proprietor of fabrication unit to obtain mandatory consent of the JKPCC and also for operating the fabrication unit without having requisite Pollution Control Devices/Pollution Control Measures ; and

Whereas, the above said order has been implemented by the District Administration, Jammu and the fabrication unit is presently closed and sealed; and

Whereas, the unit holder has represented to the J&K PCC, with the request that he will remove the heavy, noise generating machinery from the unit; and


Whereas, pursuant to this, the Divisional Officer, JKPCC, Jammu (North) after conducting inspection submitted a report to the Regional Director, PCC, Jammu vide his No. PCC/DOJN/2024/53 dated 15-06-2024 stating therein that the unit holder has requested for revocation of closure order on the ground that he will remove the heavy, noise generating machinery from the unit within a period of 15 days; and

Whereas, Regional Director, Pollution Control Committee, Jammu vide letter PCC/RDJ/C-1326/2024/975 dated 20-07-2024 confirmed the report of Divisional Officer, PCC Jammu (North) and recommended to keep the closure order in abeyance for time being to facilitate the unit holder to shift the noise generating machinery from the unit.

Now, therefore, in view of the aforesaid reasons closure order No. **327 JKPCC of 2024** dated **22-02-2024**, issued against **M/s Vishwakarma Steel Industry, Ganga Nagar, Bantalab, Jammu** is hereby kept in abeyance for a period of 15 days from the date of issuance of the order purely enabling the unit holder to shift the noise creating machinery from the present site and the unit holder will not operate the unit at the present place without obtaining consent from the JKPCC.

This Order shall remain valid only for a period of 15 days from the date of issuance.
