Whereas, no activity having bearing on environment can be taken in hand without prior consent of the Pollution Control Committee, warranted under Section 25/26 and Section 21 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 respectively.

Whereas, Brick Kiln is categorized as **Orange Category** activity on the basis of pollution potential, for the purpose of seeking the consent from the JK Pollution Control Committee.

Whereas, Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in its order dt.02-02-2024 in O.A.No.594 of 2022 titled Syed Riyaz Versus Union Territory of J&K & Ors. directed to close down the brick kilns operating without consent from the Pollution Control Committee.

Whereas, a Brick Kiln under the name and style of M/s Red Rose Brick Kiln Ichkoot Budgam is in operation in flagrant violation of above said requirements of law without obtaining consent from the J&K Pollution Control Committee, and operation of the Brick KILN in its present status can prove detrimental to human health and environment.

Whereas, fresh inspection was carried out by the Divisional Officer, Pollution Control Committee Budgam, revealing that the status of the Brick Kiln remained unchanged. Regional Director, Pollution Control Committee Kashmir confirmed the inspection report of Divisional Officer, PCC Udhampur and accordingly recommended it for closure.

Whereas, the Brick Kiln in question cannot be allowed to operate with above status as the operation can prove detrimental for human health and environment besides being in flagrant violation of laws governing environmental protection.

Now therefore in exercise of powers vested with J & K Pollution Control Board under Section 33 (A) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 31 (A) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the following directions are hereby issued:-

- i. Deputy Commissioner/ District Magistrate, Budgam is directed to close down the brick kiln under the name and style of M/s Red Rose Brick Kiln Ichkoot Budgam immediately.
- ii. Director Industries and Commerce, Kashmir is directed to deregister the Brick Kiln, if registered.
- iii. Executive Engineer, (JPDCL) Electric Division, Budgam is directed to disconnect the electric supply to above said Brick Kiln immediately.
- iv. Executive Engineer, PHE, Budgam is directed to disconnect the water supply to the above said Brick Kiln immediately.
- v. Prop. M/s Red Rose Brick Kiln Ichkoot Budgam is directed to cease the operation of the Brick Kiln, forthwith.
